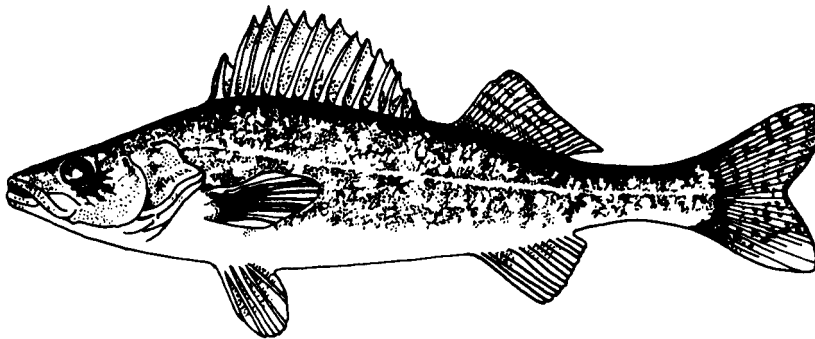


Walleye Regulations for the Red Lake River West of the Red Lake River Dam to the
Reservation Boundary

“The following regulations ONLY apply to the Red Lake River”

1. This is currently the only place on the reservation where Red Lake Tribal members are still able to harvest walleye until the regular scheduled opener on May 7th, 2011.
2. 10 walleye may be harvested daily using hook and line or spearing.
3. There is no size restriction on the walleyes taken from the Red Lake River.
4. These fish must be used for personal use only and will not be accepted at the Red Lake Fisheries.
