Assistance the owner to address compliance issues to protect the surface and groundwater resources but the owner was unwilling to work to correct compliance deficiencies. The US EPA is the regulatory agency on all Native American Trust Lands. The US EPA determined that due to the facility being out of compliance for so long, there was significant risk of contamination and the US EPA conducted an Environmental Site Assessment in 2014 which included the removal of tanks and piping. Additional sampling was conducted in 2015. Testing indicated significant contamination. The US EPA continues to fund monitoring activities.
